

Protect Mental Health Services in Pennsylvania

- In his 2009-2010 budget proposal Governor Rendell recommended a \$3 million cut in community mental health funds.
- The Senate's proposal (SB 850) slashes an additional \$24 million.
- If the proposed cuts are enacted, Pennsylvania's mental health system will NOT be able to meet the current need for ESSENTIAL services at a time when the need is rising.
